Alternate Import Demo Methods

Upscale quick demo installer is a tool to replicate the demo – including demo layout, customizer settings, posts, images and widgets to your site in a very simple process. In case you cannot see the plugins for importing demo installed or an issue arises when you're importing, you can follow these alternate methods:

One Click Demo Import

From your WordPress dashboard

1. Go to **Plugins > Add New**
2. Search for 'One Click Demo Import' and install the plugin, or click this link:

3. Activate 'One Click Demo Import' from your Plugins page.

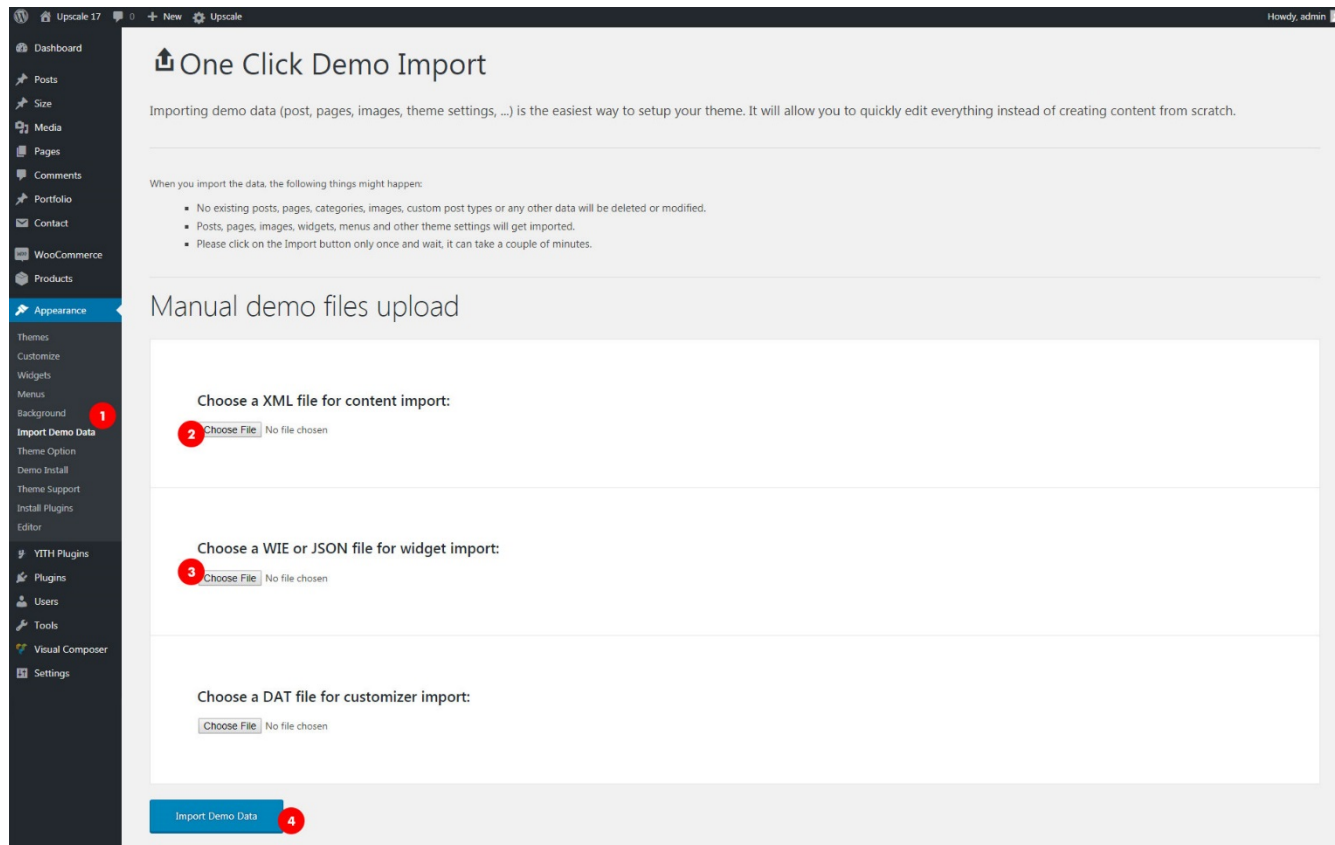
From WordPress.org

1. Download 'One Click Demo Import'

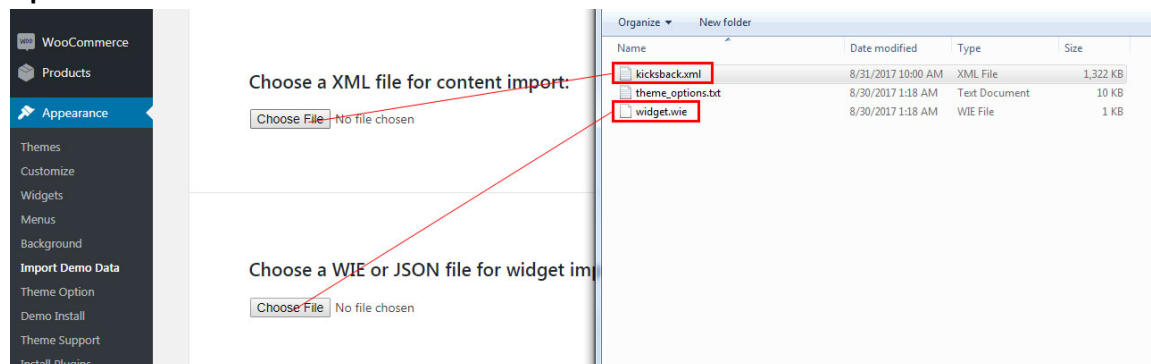
2. Upload the 'one-click-demo-import' directory to your **/wp-content/plugins/** directory, using your favorite method (ftp, sftp, scp, etc.)
3. Activate 'One Click Demo Import' from your Plugins page.

NOTE: Once the plugin is activated, you can find the actual import page in **Appearance > Import Demo Data**.

Import XML & Widget

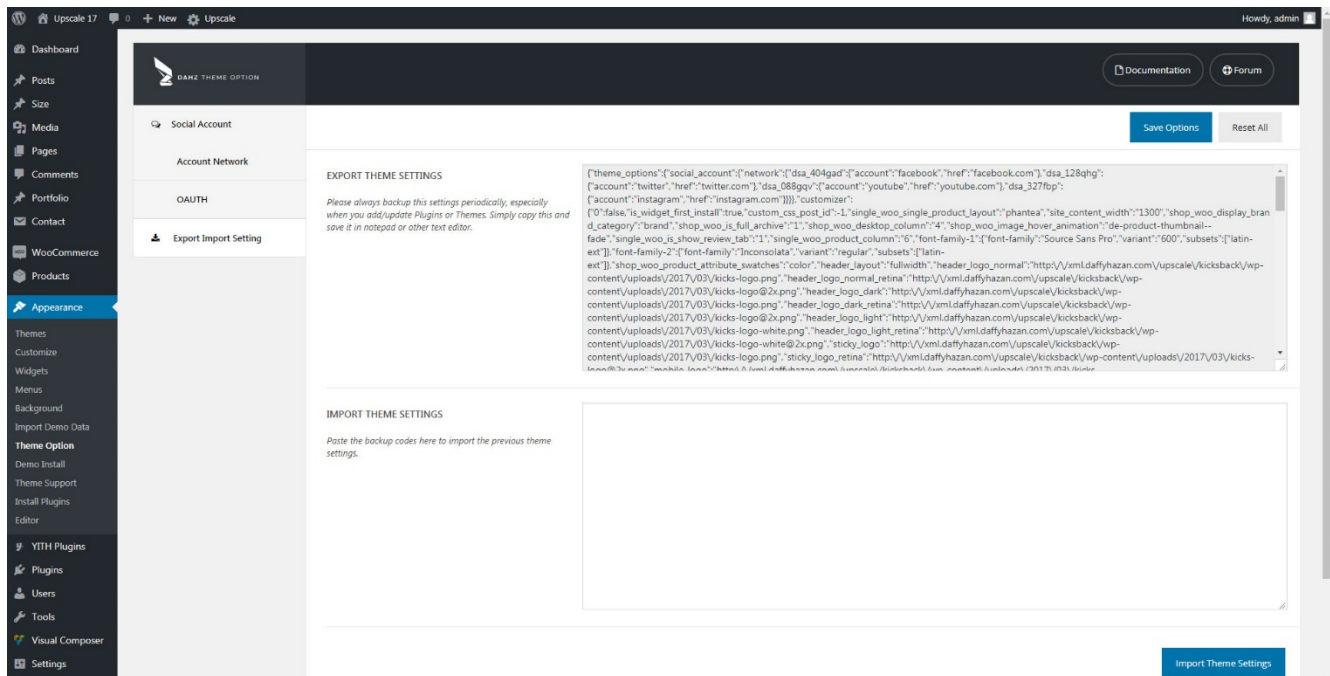


1. From your WordPress dashboard, head to **Appearance > Import Demo Data**
2. Upload the xml file of the selected demo from the folder **demo data > xml demo**

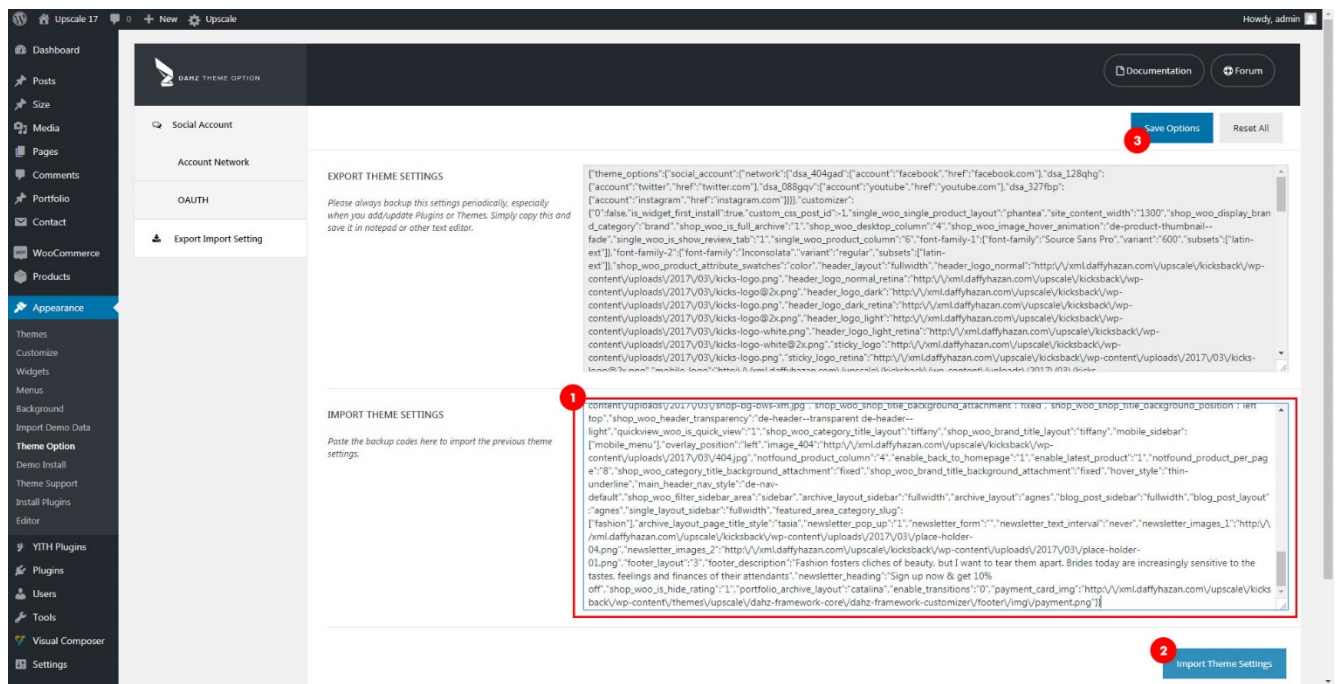


3. **Upload** the **widget.wie** of the selected theme (from the same demo folder where you get the XML file before)
4. Import the demo content.

Import Theme Options



1. From your WordPress dashboard, visit **Appearance > Theme Option > Export Import Setting**
2. From folder **demo data > xml demo**, select a demo you want to import
3. Copy the file **theme option.txt** of your selected demo then paste in the import theme setting field.



4. Click **Import Theme Setting** button
5. **Save options.**
